Objective:

The objective is

- 1. To allow the fellow to become a clinical expert in the field.
- 2. Advancing their skills to that of an intermediate / advanced gynaecological surgeon
- 3. A proficient understanding in operation of laparoscopy and hysteroscopy
- 4. To write & publish one scientific paper.

Laparoscopy & Hysteroscopy:

OT set up, Indications, risks and benefits of laparoscopic & Hysteroscopic surgery, patient positioning and preparation, technique of laparoscopy & Hysteroscopy basic (dissection, haemostasis, tissue handling, tissue retrieval, adhesion prevention), equipments & instruments used for laparoscopic surgeries & Energy sources, complications prevention, recognizing & management, basic, intermediate & advance laparoscopic & hysteroscopic procedures, anaesthesia, pre, perioperative & post operative management, sterilization & disinfection.

Role of Fellow:

The below role described is as a part of learning objective

- Complete evaluation of patients scheduled for surgery
- To recheck the preoperative orders
- To discuss the case
- To assist during surgeries & manage during post operative period & report consultant on twice daily basis until discharge. To check discharge advises.
- To edit videos for presentation
- Present case in clinical meetings.
- Assist surgeons of affiliated hospitals as per requirement.
- Fellow will assist surgeries & will be able to perform some basic procedures depending upon the assessment made weekly and acquisition of proper surgical skills had been established as assessed by consultant allotted.
- To publish 2 papers during the fellowship period (a retrospective study from hospital records)
- To attend & assist satellite centre scheduled surgeries.
- Participate in other hospital activities as per instructions and hospital policy.

Log to be maintained:

Variables will be explained & will have to daily get signed by assistant doctors of hospital.

Leave:

As per institutes policy

Duration of fellowship:

2 weeks, 4 weeks, 12 weeks, 24 weeks, 52 weeks

Examination & Assessment:

Informal, weekly assessments will be done, of subjective & objective assessment as per modules by supervisors, consultants. Whether met the expectations at the end of course. Certificate will be issued after successful completion of assessment.

There can be an exceptional instance of when the consultant feels the fellow is not able to acquire basic skills again in stipulated time as decided fellowship program can be terminated or extended for him. Fellow is than not liable for compensation of part or full the fees paid by him* .

Course fees:

- 1. 2 week course : **Rs. 75,000** (+ **18% GST**)
 4 week course : **Rs. 1 Lakh** (+ **18% GST**)
 12 week course : **Rs. 3 lakhs** (+ **18% GST**)
 24 week course : **Rs. 5 lakhs** (+ **18% GST**)
 52 weeks : **Rs. 9 lakhs** (+ **18% GST**)
- 2. NRI will have to inquire the course fees structure, which would be different.
- 3. Candidates who will do locum, for them the fees can be subsidised or can be entitled to earn some minimum stipend. Locum candidate will have to follow work profile given to him as per rules and regulation of the institutes. Approval of locum status will be course director's decision.

Eligibility:

- 1. MD or DNB from recognized university certified by MCI
- 2. DGO with 1 yr clinical experience.
- 3. Candidate should have appropriate registration with MCI.
- 4. Candidates will be required to secure their own professional liability. (will have to produce in the hospital)

Accommodation:

Fellow will arrange for his own accommodation transport & meals even when on locum

Fellow participation in educational program details:

2-4 weeks

- 3. Will have chance to attend wet lab training for 1 day on prescribed different dates
- 4. Will get chance to assist surgeries

12 weeks

- 1. Fellow will be able to observe all varieties of laparoscopic surgeries in OT.
- 2. Extensive hands on endotrainer sessions including suturing
- 3. Will get chance to assist surgeries
- 4. Fellow will have to write 1 paper & publish*
- 5. Will have more exposure of all varieties of gynaecological surgeries
- 6. Will have chance to attend wet lab training for 1 day on prescribed different dates
- 7. Will perform simple surgeries under guidance*

24 weeks / 52 weeks

- 1. Fellow will be able to observe all varieties of laparoscopic surgeries in OT.
- 2. Extensive hands on endotrainer sessions including suturing
- 3. Will get chance to assist surgeries
- 4. Fellow will have to write 2 paper & publish*
- 5. Will have more exposure of all varieties of gynaecological surgeries
- 6. Will have chance to attend wet lab training for 1 day on prescribed different dates
- 7. Will perform all surgeries under guidance*
